

Excise



1. Achievement in collection of revenue

During 2011-12 collection of excise revenue was Rs. 2101.95 crore against last year's collection of 1769.33 crore. Growth was to the tune of 18.1% over the last year's collection.

2. Achievement in preventive activities

A special thrust was given on the preventive activities during 2011-12 in order to curb the menace of consumption of illicit liquor and illegal import of duty-free liquor. The number of cases drawn up for violating Excise law during 2011-12 was 51210. The growth in preventive activity over 2010-11 was 24.5%. The number of persons arrested for violating excise law was 6782, against previous year's arrest of 4856 persons.

3. e-Governance

- a) A website of the Excise department was launched to disseminate information to the general public and to receive field information from the officers in the districts and sub-districts.
- b) The excise directorate has been connected with the network of NIC for a smooth & seamless connectivity.

- c) System for receiving duties and fees through e-gate way of bank was put in place to reduce the transaction time in payment of duties and fees on the part of the business magnets.
- d) Import Pass for Bulk spirit (IPBS) module has been introduced. On line request for Import Pass for Bulk Spirit and issuance of IPBS is now done through the module.
- e) Preventive data upload on daily basis is now done through a module in the x-PERT software.
- f) Monthly on-line revenue reporting module has been introduced in the x-PERT software.

4. Introduction ad-valorem duty in Country spirit sector

Ad-valorem duty in country spirit sector has been introduced with effect from 1st April 2012. This will make the duty structure simple and mobilise additional revenue.

5. Enhancement of duty in Foreign Liquor

Duty in foreign liquor sector was increased with effect from July, 2011 for mobilisation of additional revenue.
